#### INTRODUCTION

In order to ensure that all are enabled to grow and flourish we are committed to providing our pupils with full access to a range of information to help inform their choices.

This policy statement sets out our arrangements for managing the access of providers to pupils at the school for the purpose of giving them this information about the providers' education or training offer.
