Important Calendar Notices

As we approach the last month of the school year it is also a very busy time with lots of events taking place. These include a full programme of school trips, summer concerts, Year 11 leavers' Celebrations, new Year 7 Inductions days, and some of our pupils participating in the Salvatorian College School play. All of these events will have been shared with specific year groups if they affect your daughter. However, in addition I wanted to remind you of some upcoming dates that have been shared with you since the start of the school year

Friday, 30th June Sacred Heart Day. This is a special day to celebrate our feast day as a school. Each year this includes a special prizegiving and a community celebration. The whole school will be provided with a barbecue in the playground so hopefully the weather will stay dry. Pupils will be dismissed at 1pm.

Further Strike Days
