To help this is important that all these are raised with the correct person. The information below will assist.

Any general concerns in relation to your daughter's wellbeing you should contact your child's Form Tutor. If you feel your concern has not been addressed you should then go to the Head of Year.

If the concerns are in relation to a subject matter, please contact her subject teacher and then the Head of Department.

If you feel the issue has not been satisfactorily resolved then please contact a member of the senior leadership team or raise the issue with:

Should you wish to make a complaint about a member of staff, please write to Mrs N. Walsh, our Headteacher.

Our normal expectation is that this structure will be able to resolve any issues. However, if you have met with the Headteacher and you consider that a proper process has not been followed you may make a formal complaint to our Chair of the Governing Body. The full process can be found in our complaints policy. Please be aware that any complaint cannot go to the governing body until all avenues have been explored with the Headteacher.
