Today is the Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows

The Memorial of Our Lady of Sorrows commemorates the seven sorrows in the Heart of Mary as recorded in Scripture:

Reader 1 The prophecy of Simeon (Luke 2:33–35)

Reader 2 The flight into Egypt (Matthew 2:13–15)

Reader 3 Loss of the Child Jesus for three days (Luke 2:41–50)

Reader 4 Mary meets Jesus on His way to Calvary (Luke 23:27–31; John 19:17)

Reader 5 Crucifixion and Death of Jesus (John 19:25–30)

Reader 6 The body of Jesus being taken from the Cross (Luke 23:50–54; John 19:31–37)

Reader 7 The burial of Jesus (Isaiah 53:8–9; Luke 23:50–56; John 19:38–42; Mark 15:40–47)

What is God's message for you today?





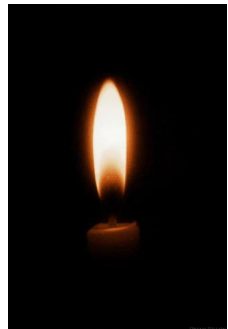
