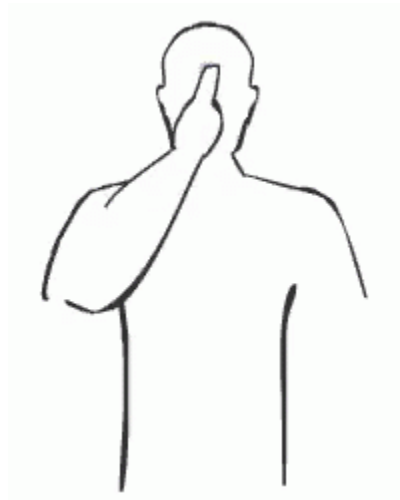

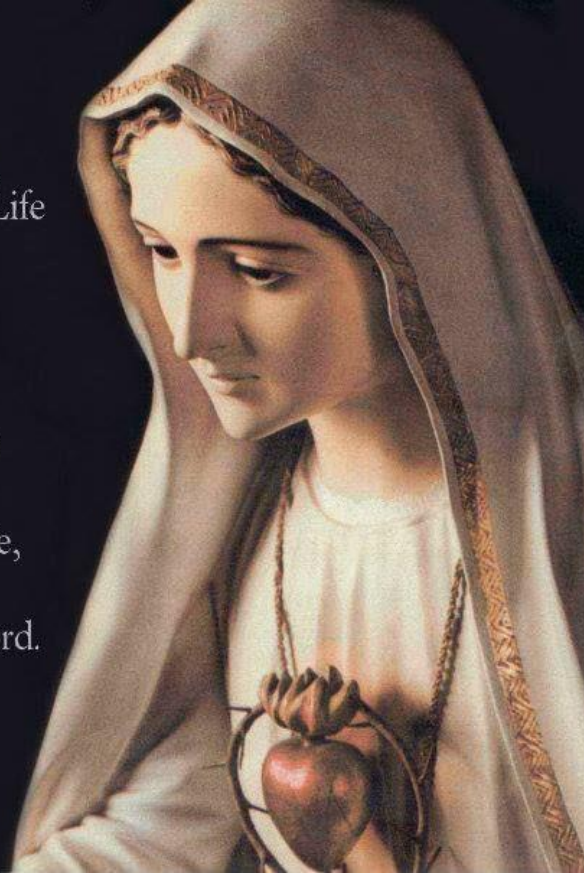

How can I ensure I follow Jesus' teachings to be the best person I can be?



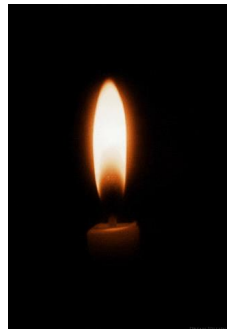
Word Wednesday
