'You have heard how it was said, You shall not commit adultery. But I say this to you, if a man looks at a woman lustfully, he has already committed adultery with her in his heart. If your right eye should be your downfall, tear it out and throw it away; for it will do you less harm to lose one part of yourself than to have your whole body thrown into hell. and if your right hand should be your downfall, cut it off and throw it away; for it will do you less harm to lose one part of yourself than to have your whole body go to hell.'

Reader: The Gospel of the Lord

All: Praise to you Lord Jesus Christ





Word Wednesday



This passage is about the seriousness of lust and the need for extreme measures to avoid sin, as Jesus teaches that lustful intent is a form of betrayal in the heart, not just the physical act.

To prevent sin and maintain purity, he uses figurative language, saying it is better to "cut off" a hand or "tear out" an eye that leads to sin, than to have one's whole body cast into hell.



Word Wednesday



Reflection

In Christian Theology the seed of all sin is Original Sin. Adam and Eve knew that eating the fruit from the tree in the Garden of Eden would lead to suffering but the desire for short term pleasure overcame their better judgement.

We know it is bad for us to eat an extra three cream cakes, but if we really want them, we ignore our worry... until the last mouthful has been eaten.

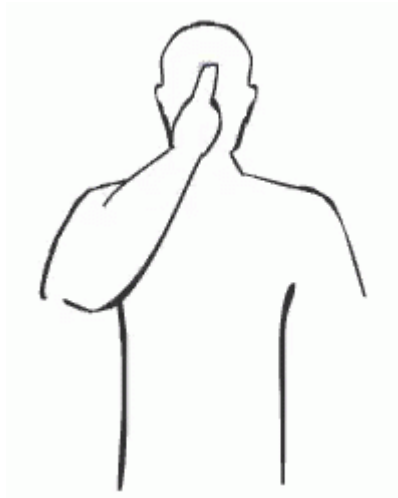

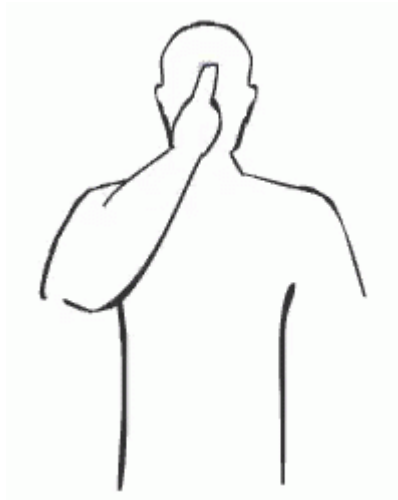
