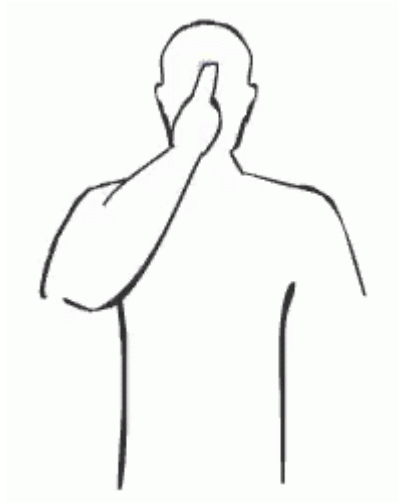

Gold: Represents Jesus' kingship.

Frankincense: Symbolises Jesus' divinity, as it was used in worship.

Myrrh: A substance used for embalming, it foretells his humanity and eventual death and burial.

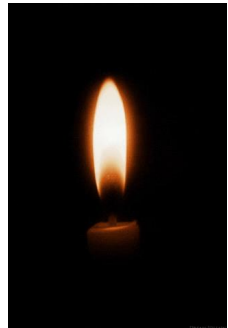

So, you should pray like this: Our Father in heaven, may your name be held holy, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we have forgiven those who are in debt to us. And do not put us to the test, but save us from the Evil One.'

'And when you pray, do not imitate the hypocrites: they love to say their prayers standing up in the synagogues and at the street corners for people to see them. In truth I tell you, they have had their reward. But when you pray, go to your private room, shut yourself in, and so pray to your Father who is in that secret place, and your Father who sees all that is done in secret will reward you.'

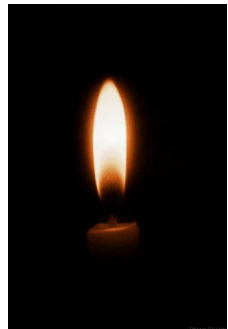


Word Wednesday

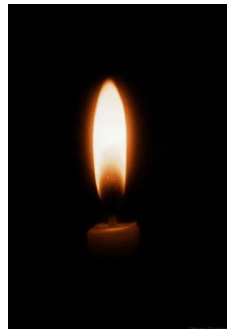
