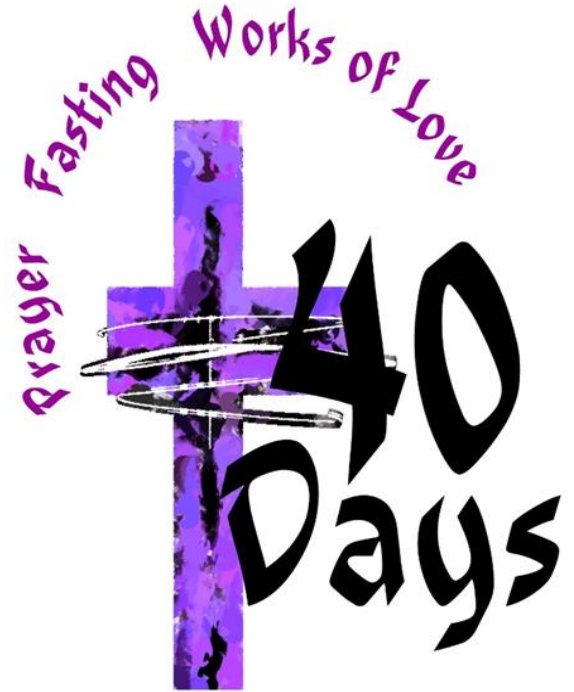
Monday 'Peace be with you'

It is a period of forty days reflecting the time Jesus spent in the desert fasting and praying to God the Father.

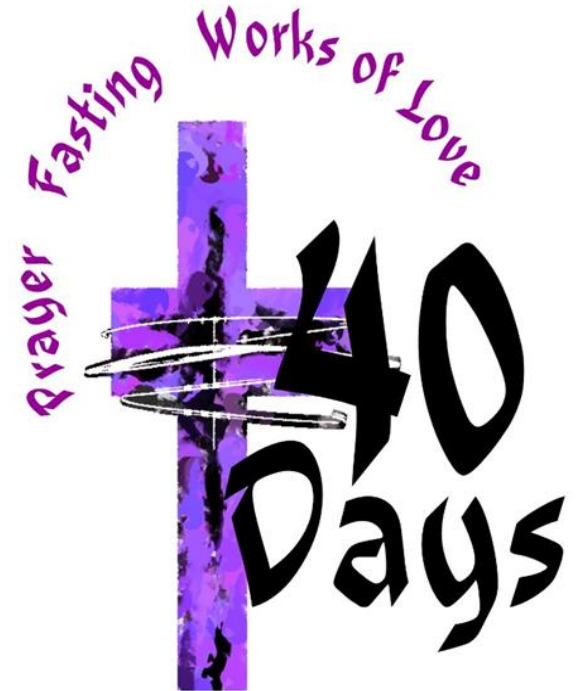




Monday 'Peace be with you'



Lent is an opportunity for each of us to examine and renew our relationship with Christ.

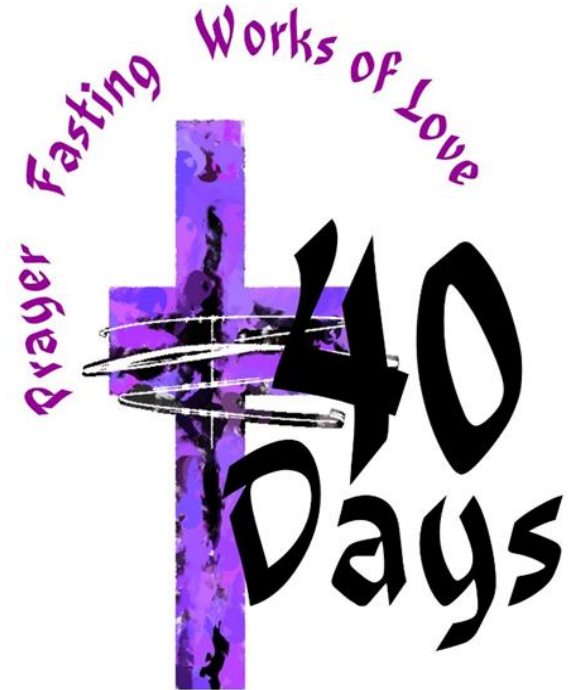




Monday 'Peace be with you'



Lent gives us the opportunity to examine our conscience, seek forgiveness, and renew our commitment to living as Christ calls us to live.

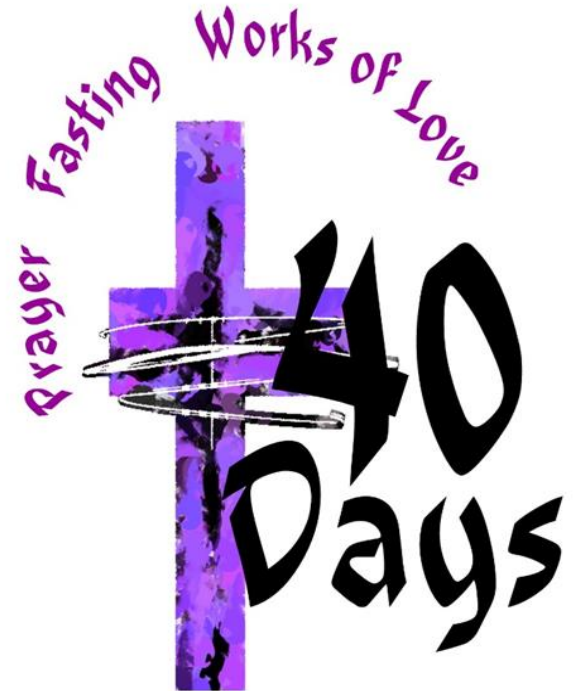




Monday 'Peace be with you'

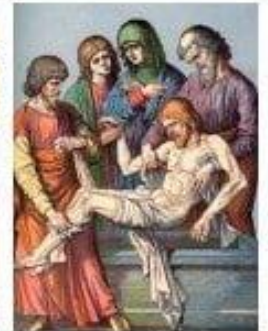

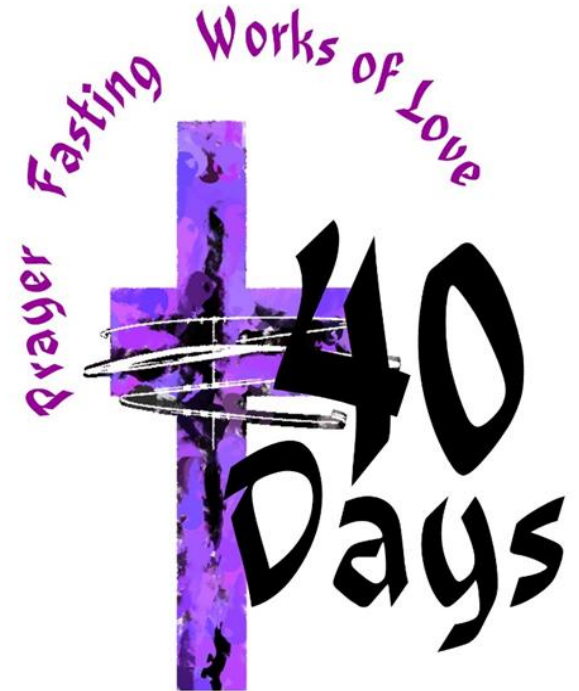

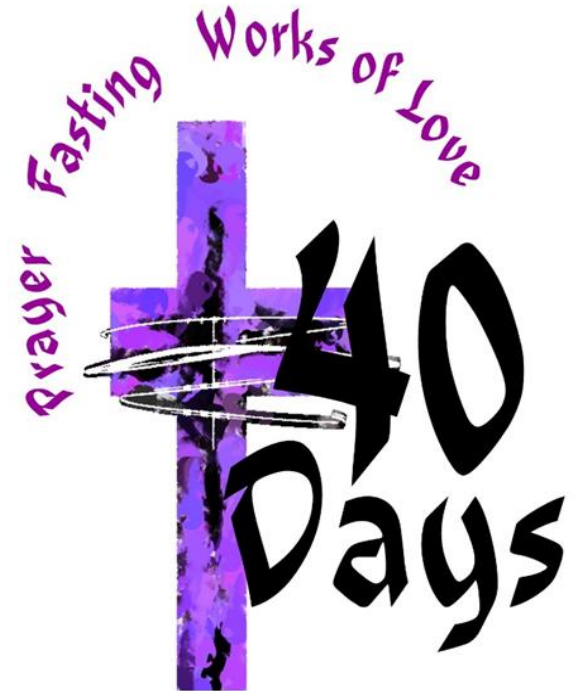

How do we feel on such occasions?





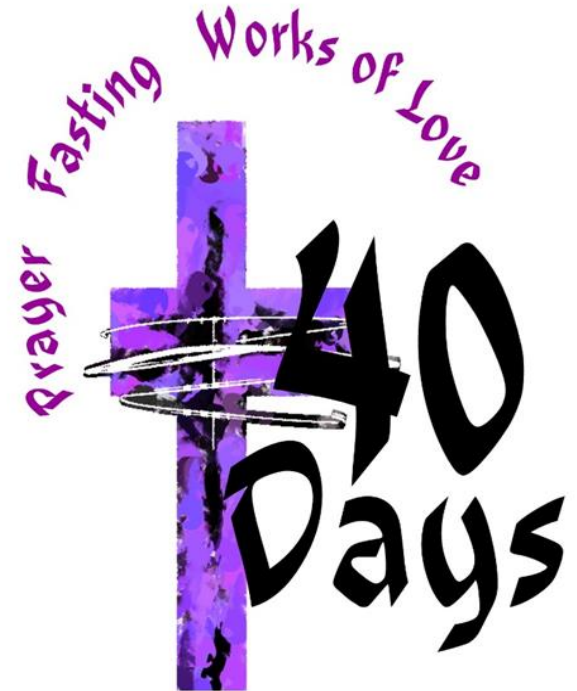

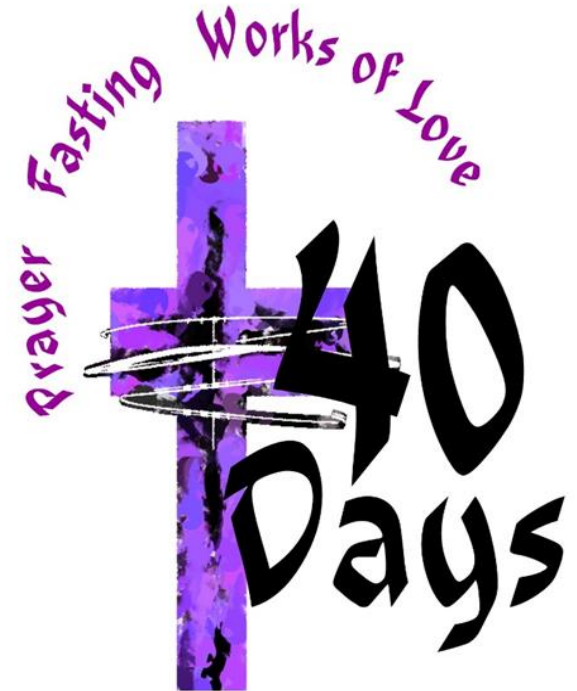


Our CST focus for this half term is **the preferential option for the poor and vulnerable.**

(3 crosses Forehead, Heart and Lips)

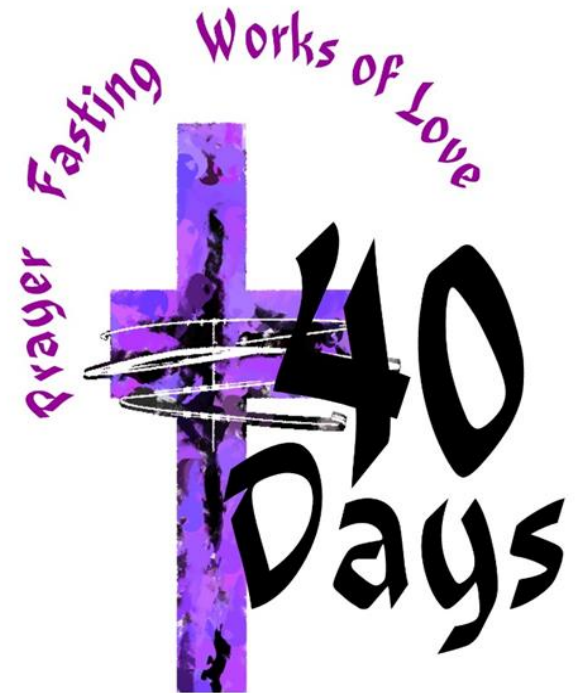




Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'

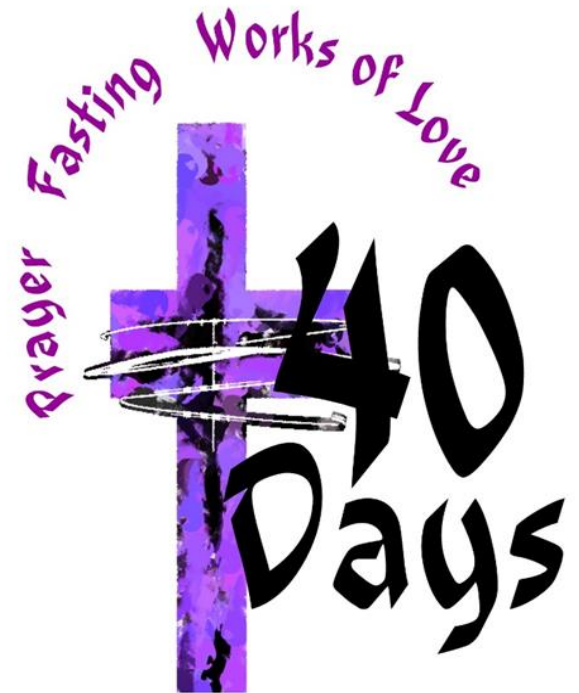




Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'

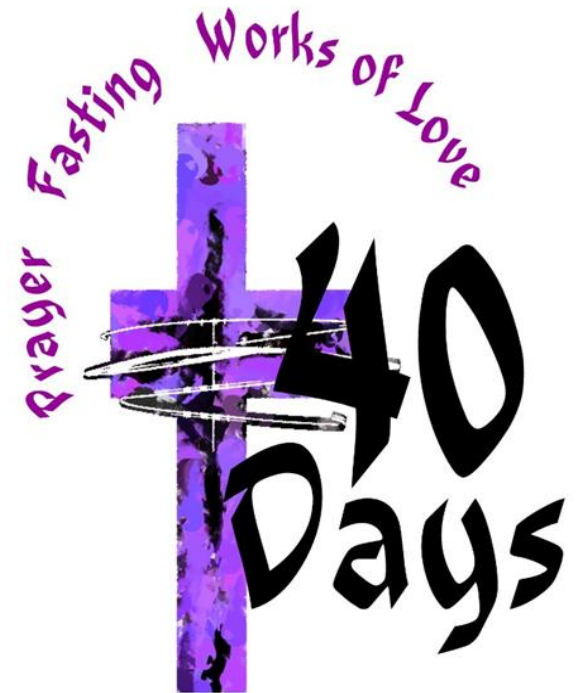

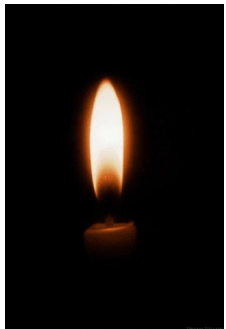
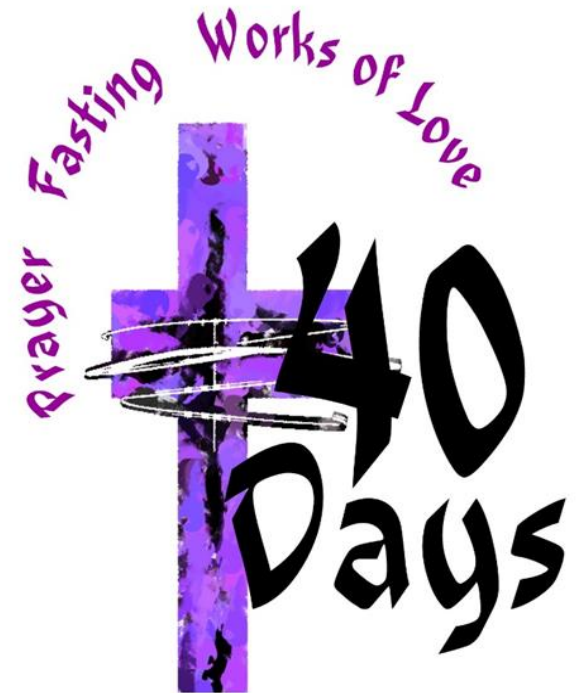

This was the reading for Ash Wednesday (the beginning of Lent) on the 18th February.





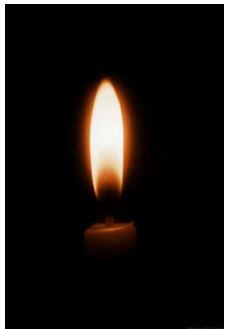
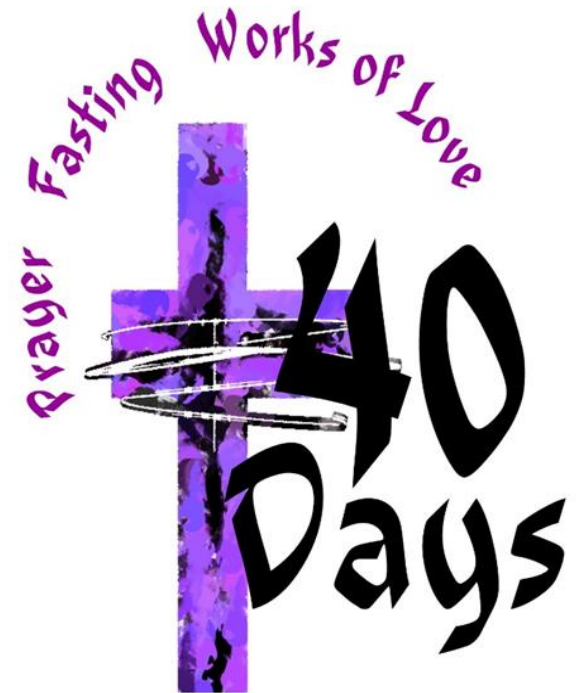
Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'

Do I pray quietly and sincerely to God?





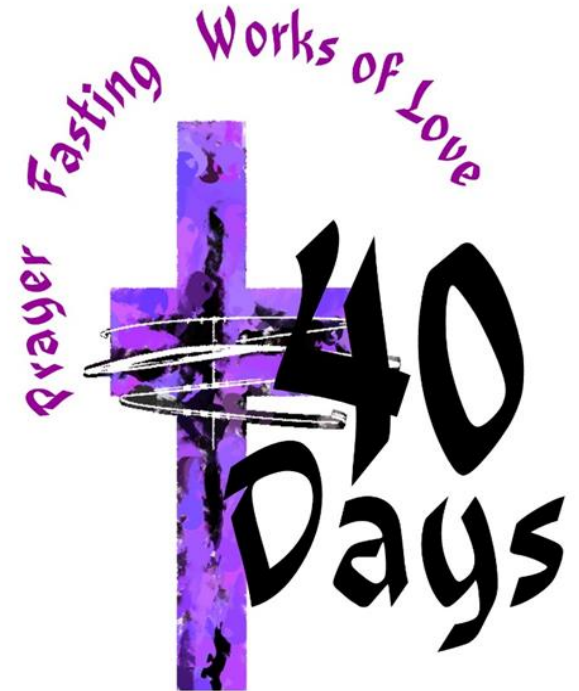
Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'

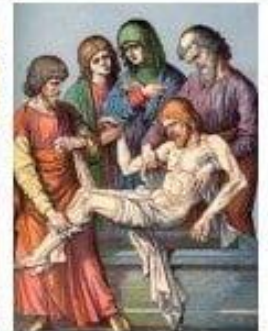

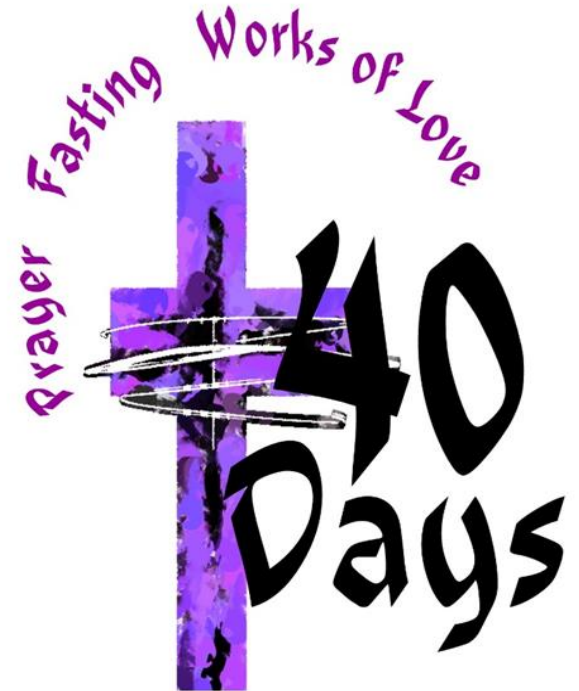

you have redeemed the world.*





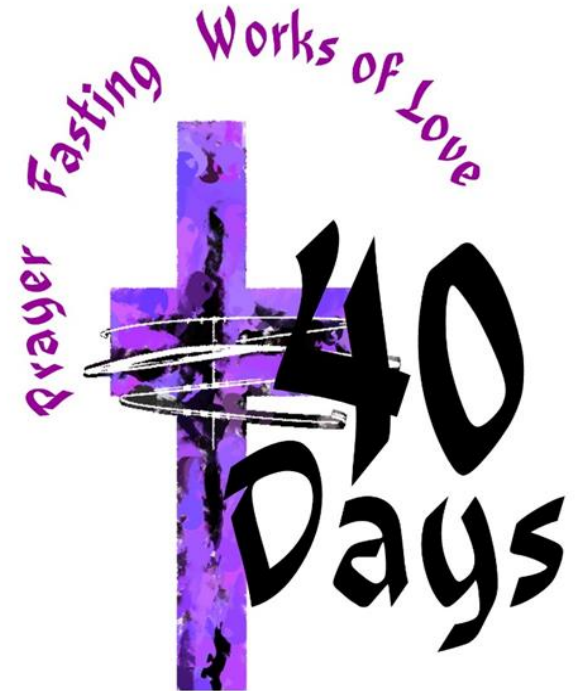
Friday 'Peace be with you'

Can we think of someone who has a cross to carry at this time and ask Jesus to help them.





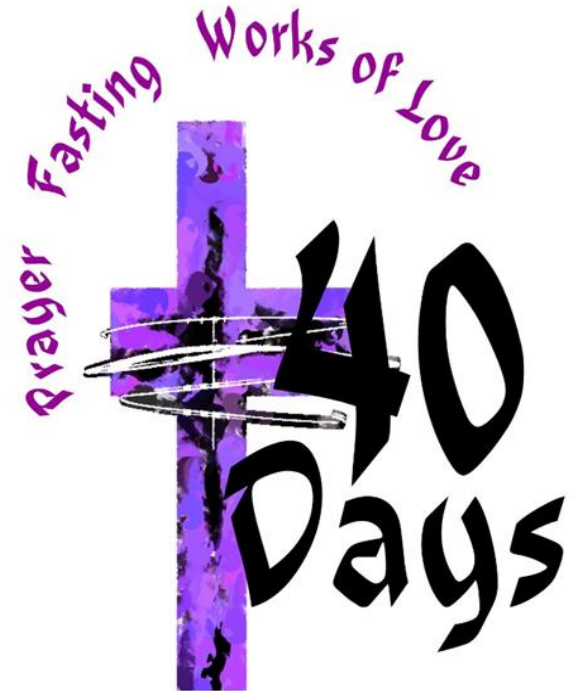
