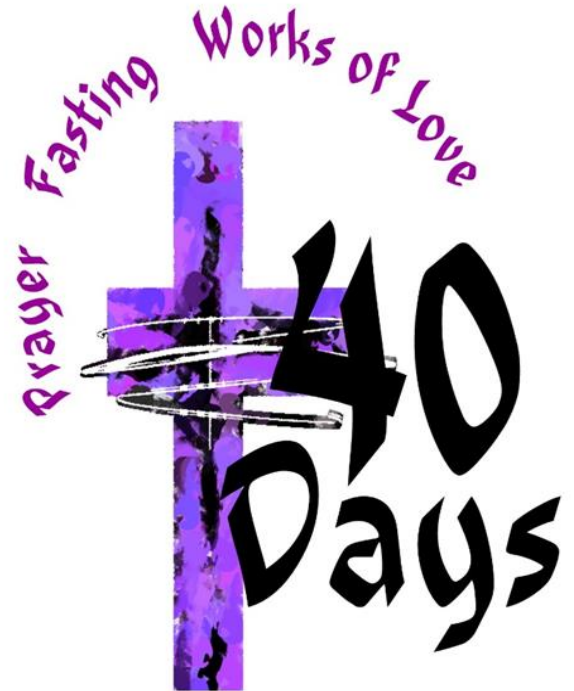

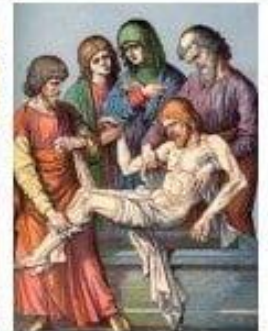

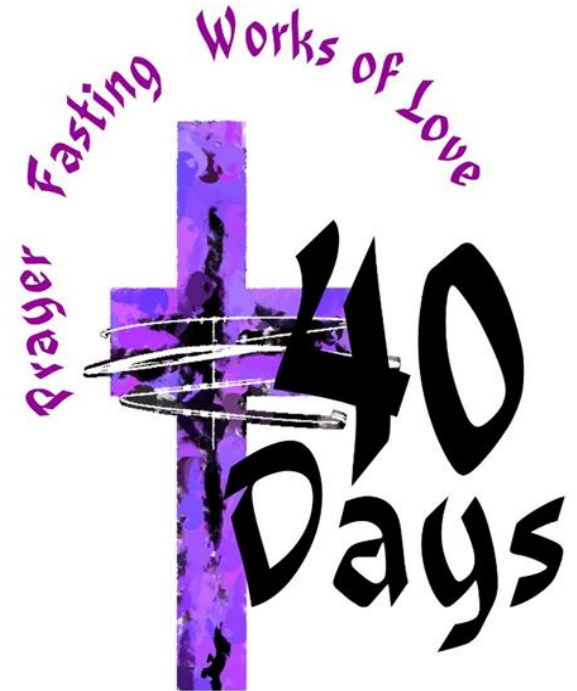


Fifth Station

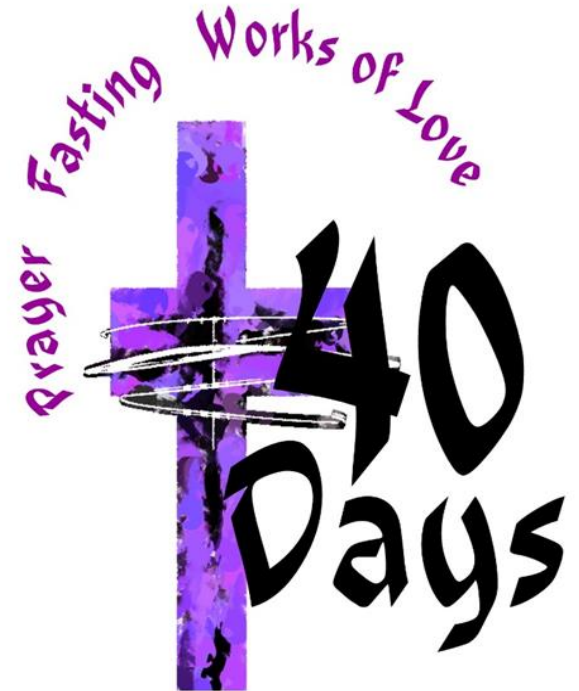


The soldiers could see that Jesus was growing tired.

How can you help others today?





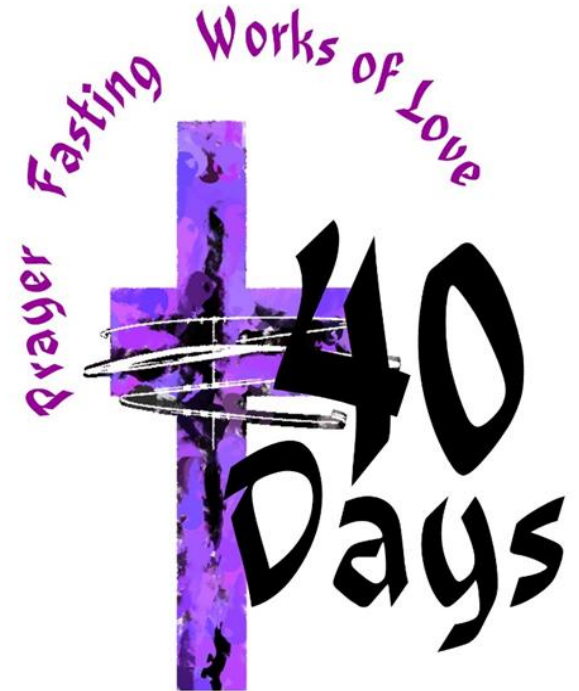

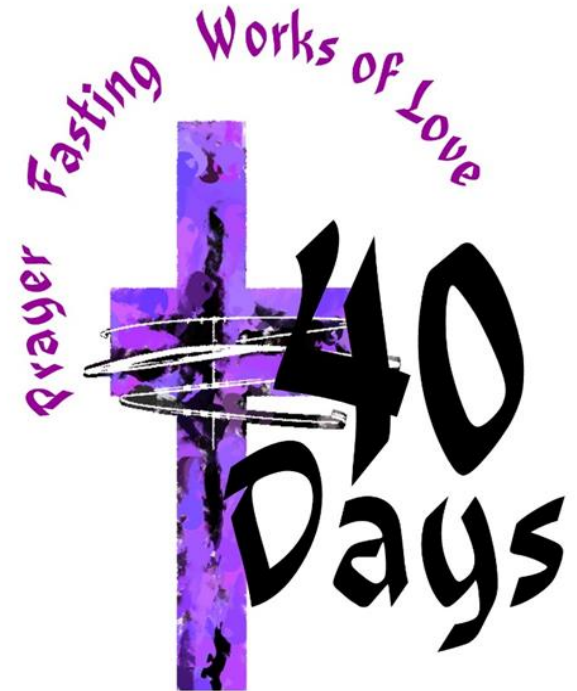
Tuesday 'Peace be with you'

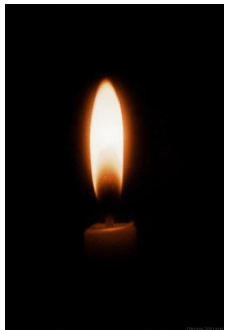


Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'

(3 crosses Forehead, Heart and Lips)





Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



Leaving that place, Jesus withdrew to the region of Tyre and Sidon. A Canaanite woman from that vicinity came to him, crying out, “Lord, Son of David, have mercy on me! My daughter is demon-possessed and suffering terribly.”

Jesus did not answer a word. So, his disciples came to him and urged him, “Send her away, for she keeps crying out after us.”

He answered, “I was sent only to the lost sheep of Israel.”

The woman came and knelt before him. “Lord, help me!” she said.

He replied, “It is not right to take the children’s bread and toss it to the dogs.”

“Yes, it is, Lord,” she said. “Even the dogs eat the crumbs that fall from their master’s table.”

Then Jesus said to her, “Woman, you have great faith! Your request is granted.” And her daughter was healed at that moment.

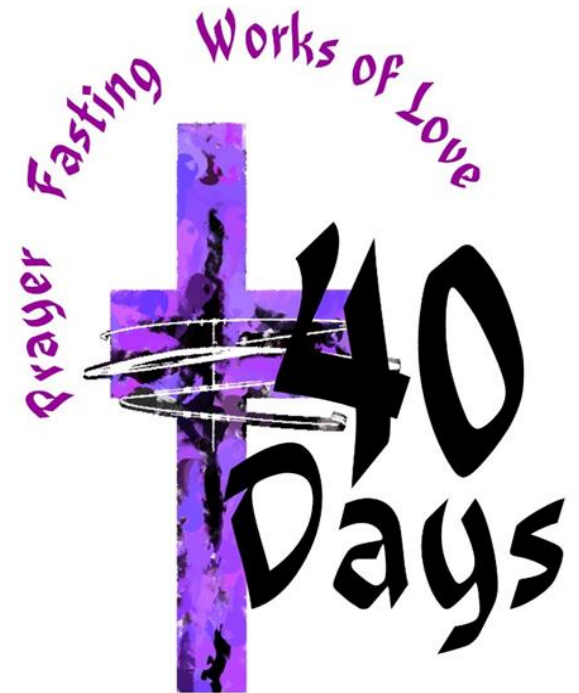

Christ**





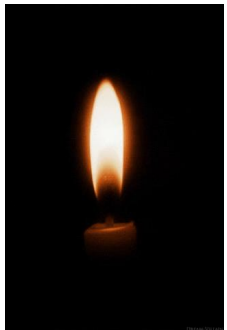
Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



The reading shows that faith knows no boundaries and persistence in prayer is rewarded.

The woman did not give up, even when Jesus seemed to ignore her. She showed that true faith keeps asking and trusting.

She did not ask for a miracle because she deserved it, but because she knew she needed Jesus' mercy. She acknowledged her need for Him.





Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



Jesus showed that salvation is not just for a select few, but for all people, even those who seem like outsiders or are different from us.

Jesus was not being cruel but teaching that the "crumbs" of his grace are enough to change lives. He honored her desperate, honest love for her daughter.

Reflection Question:

When you feel ignored or think your prayers are not heard, will you keep trusting in Jesus like the woman in the Gospel?



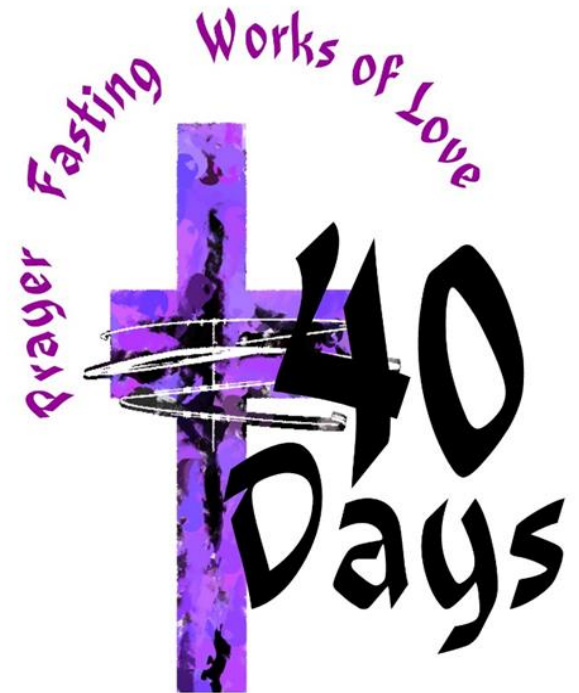

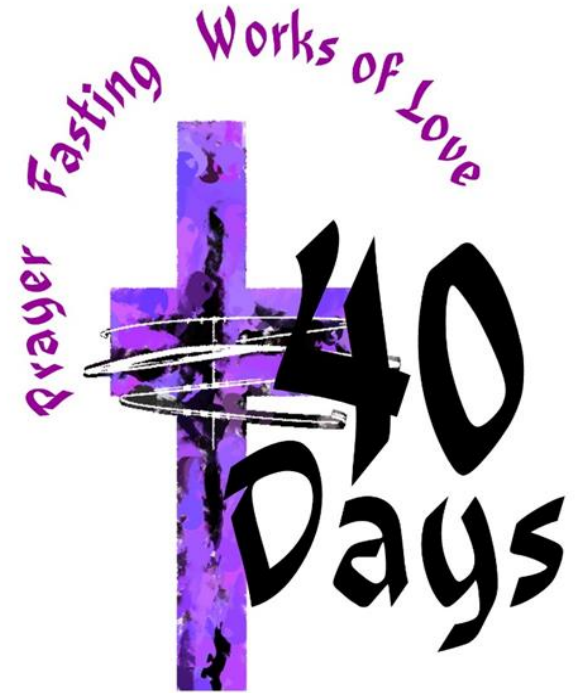


Sixth Station

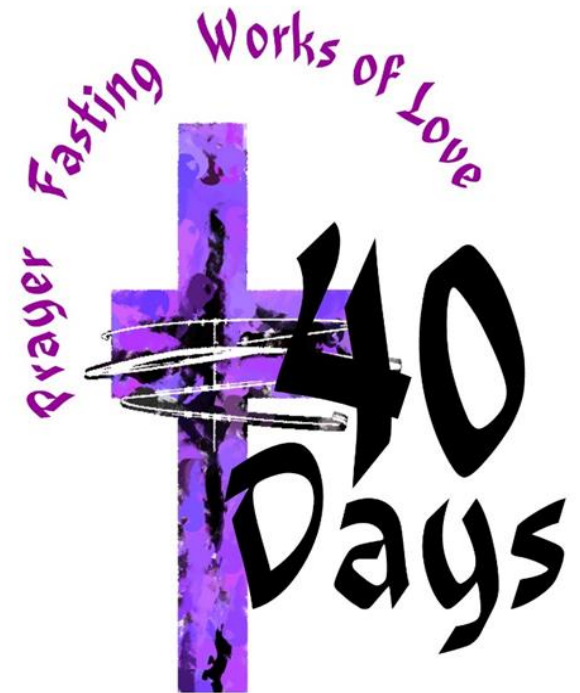


A good woman named Veronica came up to Jesus and wiped his face.

Can we reach out in love to others today?





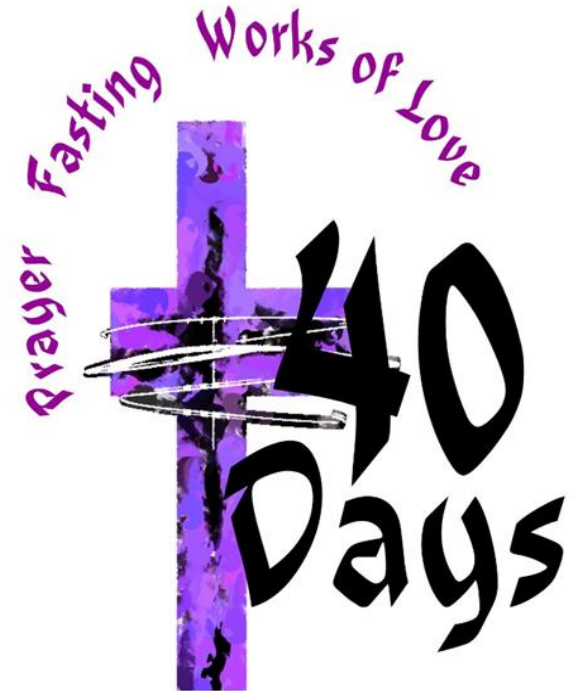
