# Monday 'Peace be with you'



**This week is the second week of Easter.**

The weeks following Easter focus on Jesus's appearances after His Resurrection, highlighting themes of peace, belief, doubt, and Divine Mercy.

Yesterday was Divine Mercy Sunday, when we heard about Thomas, one of the disciples who had not been present when the risen Jesus first appeared.

The Gospel reading describes Thomas refusing to believe in the Resurrection until he can see and touch Jesus's wounds for himself. Eight days later, Jesus appears again, invites Thomas to touch His wounds, and says, "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed." Thomas responds, "My Lord and my God."

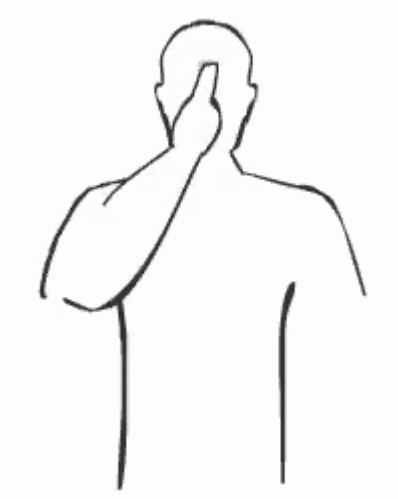

# Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



At that time, Jesus said to his disciples: 'Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened. Or which one of you, if his son asks him for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a serpent? If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask him! So whatever you wish that others would do to you, do also to them, for this is the Law and the Prophets.'



# Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



This reading is known as the **Golden Rule** (“do to others what you would have them do to you”). It links directly to Jesus’s teaching on prayer. Because we receive good gifts from God, we are encouraged to be generous and kind to others, treating them with the same grace we have received.

**Ask, seek, knock:** Jesus invites us to bring our needs, our friendships, our school life, our hopes and plans, to God.

We are called to build an active, trusting relationship with God, allowing that relationship to shape and transform how we treat everyone around us.
