And you know the way to where I am going.' Thomas said to him, 'Lord, we do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?' Jesus said to him, 'I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.'

# Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



## Reflection Points:

**Do Not Let Your Hearts Be Troubled:** Jesus knows life brings worry: school, friendships, the future, family. He calls you to trust Him as your steady anchor.

**A Place Prepared:** Heaven is a real home with room for you, where God's presence removes pain, anxiety, and fear.

**Jesus is the Way:** He does not just point the way; He *is* the way. He walks with you, and when you are worn out, He carries you.

**Jesus is the Truth:** In a world full of mixed messages and pressure, Jesus is the solid foundation of truth you can measure everything against.

**Jesus is the Life:** He offers real life now, purpose, peace, and love that continues forever.



# Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



## Reflection:

- 1. Trust over Fear:** When anxiety rises, consciously choose to trust that Jesus has a plan rather than worrying.
- 2. Evaluate the Path:** Are you following Jesus as "the" way, or trying to find your own way?
- 3. Find Peace in His Presence:** Remember that Jesus does not abandon his followers; He prepares a place for them.

He chose his name in honour of the last Pope Leo, Leo XIII (Pope from 1878 to 1903).

Leo XIII was a defender of exploited workers. He saw that they had no voice, worked every waking hour, and were left with no time for rest or family.

“During an era marked by the rise of capitalism and the exploitation of labourers, Pope Leo XIII boldly defended the rights of workers and the sanctity of the family.”

He is regarded as a founder of Catholic Social Teaching, and our theme for this half term, the Rights and Dignity of Workers, stands firmly on his teaching.

During the month of May, we give special attention in our prayer to Mary, especially through the Rosary.

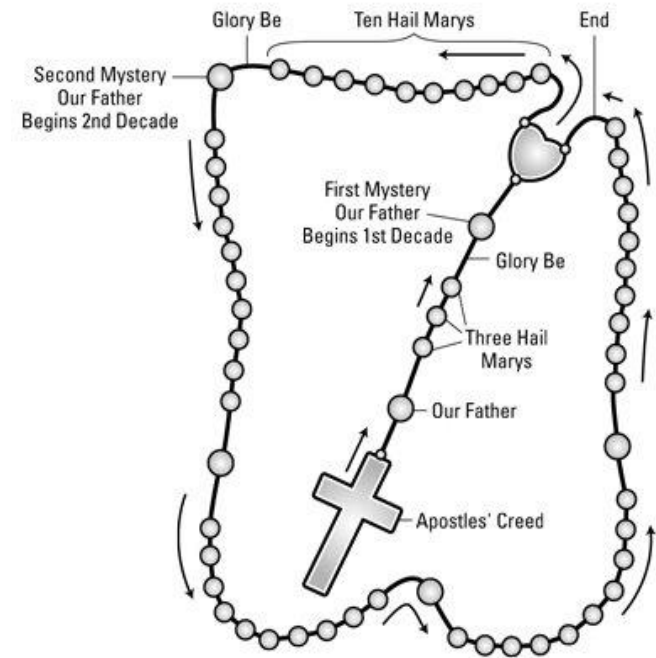
