Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



At that time, Jesus lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, 'Father, the hour has come; glorify your Son that the Son may glorify you, since you have given him authority over all flesh, to give eternal life to all whom you have given him. And this is eternal life, that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent. I glorified you on earth, having accomplished the work that you gave me to do. And now, Father, glorify me in your own presence with the glory that I had with you before the world existed. 'I have manifested your name to the people whom you gave me out of the world. Yours they were, and you gave them to me, and they have kept your word.



Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



Now they know that everything that you have given me is from you. For I have given them the words that you gave me, and they have received them and have come to know in truth that I came from you; and they have believed that you sent me. I am praying for them. I am not praying for the world but for those whom you have given me, for they are yours. All mine are yours, and yours are mine, and I am glorified in them. And I am no longer in the world, but they are in the world, and I am coming to you.

In that day you will know that I am in my Father, and you in me, and I in you. Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves me. And he who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and manifest myself to him.

Reader: The Gospel of the Lord
All: Praise to You Lord Jesus Christ





Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



In this passage, Jesus teaches that loving him means keeping his commands, and in return he promises to send the Holy Spirit as an “Advocate” (Helper) who will remain with believers forever. For us, this means we are never alone or abandoned, because the Spirit acts as an inner guide and comforter, strengthening us to live out our faith even when it feels difficult.



Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



Reflection:

Love is Active, Not Just a Feeling: Jesus ties love directly to obedience, suggesting that following his teachings is the real way to show love.

You Are Never Alone: Jesus promises not to leave us as "orphans," assuring us that even if he is not physically present, the Holy Spirit lives within believers.





Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



The Holy Spirit is Your "Helper": The Spirit (or Advocate) acts as a counsellor to guide us into truth, comfort us in stress, and help us navigate hard decisions.

A Personal Relationship with God: Jesus promises that those who follow him will experience his love and presence intimately, making their home with them.

David Attenborough celebrated his 100th birthday last week on Friday May 8th.





Thursday 'Peace be with you'



He is a legendary broadcaster and naturalist who revolutionised natural history television over a 70-year career. Famous for bringing the world into living rooms, he has over 50 species named after him, was knighted twice, and holds records for both deep-sea diving and television technology.





Thursday 'Peace be with you'



Here are five interesting facts about David Attenborough:

He has over 50 species named after him: Numerous plants, insects, and prehistoric creatures bear his name, including a giant carnivorous plant (*Nepenthes attenboroughii*), a beetle (*Micridium attenboroughi*), and a butterfly.

He was originally rejected by the BBC: When applying for a radio talk producer position early in his career, he was rejected. He later joined as a trainee in 1952 and didn't even own a television at the time, which was common in Britain.

He is a record-breaking broadcaster: He is the only person to have won BAFTAs for programs broadcast in black and white, colour, HD, 3D, and 4K.

He dived 300 meters in a submersible: In 2015, at the age of 89, he broke the record for the deepest ever dive on the Great Barrier Reef in Australia to film unseen parts of the ocean.

He does not consider himself an "animal lover": Attenborough has noted that the term "animal lover" implies a sentimental feeling. Instead, he finds animals "rivetingly interesting" and experiences "huge intellectual pleasure" studying them, rather than a romanticized love for them.

Bonus Fact: He was once swarmed by baby mountain gorillas in Rwanda, a moment he described as "bliss".
