Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



At that time, Jesus lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, 'Father, the hour has come; glorify your Son that the Son may glorify you, since you have given him authority over all flesh, to give eternal life to all whom you have given him. And this is eternal life, that they know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent. I glorified you on earth, having accomplished the work that you gave me to do. And now, Father, glorify me in your own presence with the glory that I had with you before the world existed.'



Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



I have manifested your name to the people whom you gave me out of the world. Yours they were, and you gave them to me, and they have kept your word. Now they know that everything that you have given me is from you. For I have given them the words that you gave me, and they have received them and have come to know in truth that I came from you; and they have believed that you sent me. I am praying for them. I am not praying for the world but for those whom you have given me, for they are yours. All mine are yours, and yours are mine, and I am glorified in them. And I am no longer in the world, but they are in the world, and I am coming to you.

Reader: The Gospel of the Lord
All: Praise to You Lord Jesus Christ





Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



In this passage, Jesus prays for his followers just before his crucifixion, focusing on unity, protection, and the true meaning of eternal life as knowing God. This passage highlights that we are loved, known by name, and called to a purposeful life that stands out in modern society.





Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



Reflection:

Eternal Life Now: Jesus defines eternal life not just as a future event, but as knowing God intimately today, right now.

You Are Known: Jesus prays specifically for his disciples, including us today, showing a personal connection rather than a distant religious rule.





Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



The Call to Unity: Jesus prays that his followers will be "one," just as he and the Father are one. This means fostering unity in a divided world rather than tearing others down.

Purposeful Difference: Being a follower of Jesus means being "in the world" but not defined by it, allowing love and different standards to shine.





Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



Reflection Question:

How can we live in a way that shows our connection to Jesus, rather than just knowing "about" him?

In what ways can we bring unity to our friends or school, in line with Jesus' prayer?
