Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



This passage is a reminder that God's love is not a reward for being perfect; it is a free gift of grace.

It offers us the security of unconditional acceptance, assurance against condemnation, and the purpose of living a life shaped by authentic, active faith.

"God so loved the world...". In the Bible, the "world" represents all of humanity: broken, messy, and far from perfect.





Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



You don't have to clean up your life, get straight A's, or fit a specific mould for God to love you. His love isn't based on your performance, popularity, or the mistakes you feel ashamed of. You are completely and fully loved right in the middle of your daily struggles, doubts, and triumphs.

People face pressure from social media, peers, and their own high expectations, which can lead to deep feelings of guilt and unworthiness. This verse guarantees that God is not standing over you with a clipboard waiting to punish you. Instead, through Jesus, you are offered a "not guilty" verdict, freeing you from shame.



Word Wednesday 'Peace be with you'



"Whoever believes in him is not condemned..."

Believing isn't just knowing facts about God; it's trusting Him with your life. It means turning away from things that bring you down (like anxiety, comparison, and fear) and leaning into the truth that you are deeply valued.

Daily Consecration to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

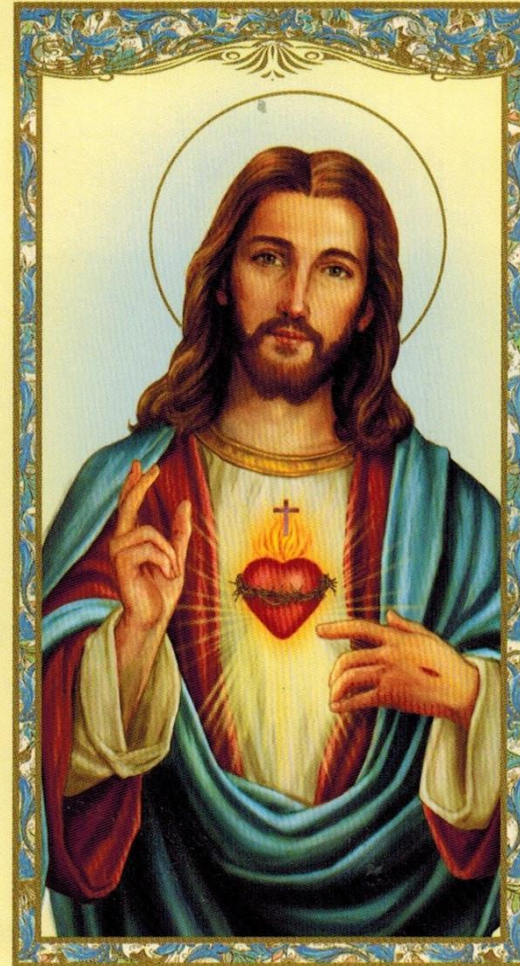
