The school began officially in January 2020 with seventeen pupils in pre-primary to class 1. This was a joyful start, and parents hope that it will continue to go up to a good primary.

This project will benefit the pupil of Mbajone village directly by providing a quality education and giving the pupils good education.

Take a moment to think about the themes and consider how they apply to our daily life:

Unwavering Value: When you face criticism, cancel culture, or self-doubt, does it change how you view your self-worth? How can you ground your identity in God's specific, personal care rather than in what others think?

Practicing Courage: Think about a situation in your life right now where you need to stand up for what is right (e.g., stopping a rumor, defending someone, or being honest). How can you use the reminder "do not be afraid" to take action?

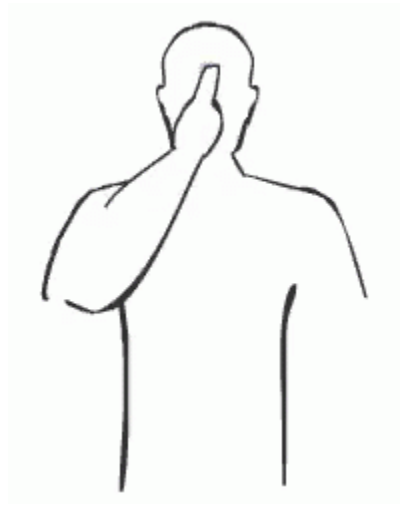

May we take a moment to pray for all our sisters around the world who will also be celebrating in Sacred Heart schools.

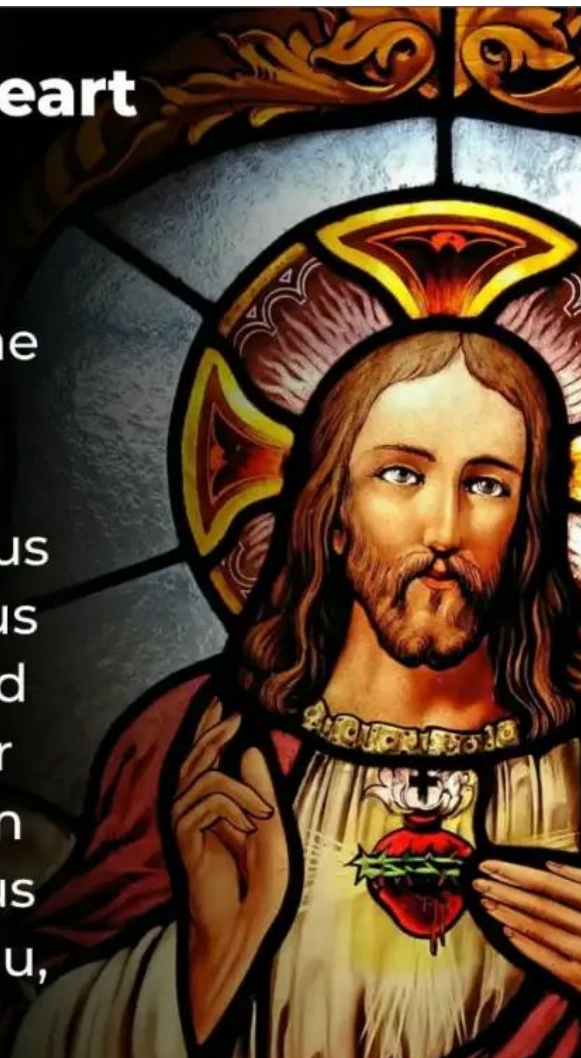




Friday 'Peace be with you'

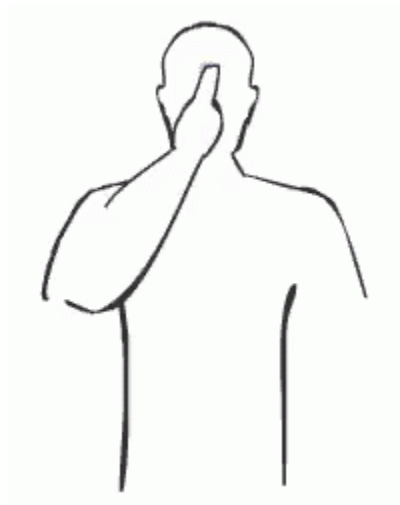


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
