EDUCATION OF CHILDREN, INDIA CENTRAL

Kuchinda village in Odisha, there are several primary schools, but the annual Status of Education Report shows that the quality of government primary education in Odisha has declined. School infrastructure is very poor and very badly maintained. There is very little access to quality education for children.

Location: Kuchinda is a tribal town in the Indian State of Odisha.

Goals: The RNDM mission in Odisha serves the marginalised children of Kuchinda district. The aim of the project is to impart basic quality education to the children attending public schools, who are deprived of good educational opportunities.

Activities: The Sisters engage themselves in the ministries of education and social development. They run nine Supplementary Education Centres in Kuchinda, for over 200 children from remote villages who attend these classes. Through these centres, they gain literacy and are empowered to join formal school.

Beneficiaries: more than 200 children of Kuchinda district are receiving help from this project.

Request: The project requires financial support to continue reaching out to the most marginalised and deprived children of the district and give them a brighter future.

"At that time: Jesus said to his disciples: 'I tell you, unless your righteousness exceeds that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven. You have heard that it was said to those of old, "You shall not murder; and whoever murders will be liable to judgement." But I say to you that everyone who is angry with his brother will be liable to judgement; whoever insults his brother will be liable to the council; and whoever says, "You fool!" will be liable to the hell of fire.

So, if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother has something against you, leave your gift there before the altar and go. First be reconciled to your brother, and then come and offer your gift. Come to terms quickly with your accuser while you are going with him to court, lest your accuser hand you over to the judge, and the judge to the guard, and you be put in prison. Truly, I say to you, you will never get out until you have paid the last penny."

'Peace be with you'



In a moment of silent prayer reflect on the words of the Gospel.

In this passage, Jesus challenges us to look beyond simply "following the rules." He equates deep-seated anger and insulting words to the sin of murder, and calls for immediate reconciliation. True righteousness is not just about avoiding bad behaviour; it is about cultivating a loving and forgiving heart.



Word Wednesday

'Peace be with you'



- Jesus says our actions need to go deeper than those of the rule-followers of His day. This means avoiding mean-spirited gossip, cyberbullying, or hateful thoughts and not just avoiding getting in trouble at school or home.
- Jesus warns that calling someone a "fool" (which translates today to using degrading, insulting, or hurtful language) is spiritually dangerous. Words have the power to tear down or build up, and Jesus calls for a higher standard of respect.
- Jesus tells us that unresolved conflict ruins our connection with God. If you know a friend is mad at you, or if you are harbouring anger toward a sibling, drop what you are doing and take the first step toward making things right.

What can we do?

- **Check Your Social Media:** Before you post a snarky comment or share a meme meant to embarrass someone, pause. Ask yourself: Does this reflect the love and respect Jesus expects from me?
- **Be the Peacemaker:** Swallow your pride and take the first step to apologise, even if you feel you were only partly to blame.
- **Address the Anger:** When you feel intense anger or jealousy building, talk to a trusted person. Venting in a healthy way prevents bitterness from taking root in your heart.

Amen."

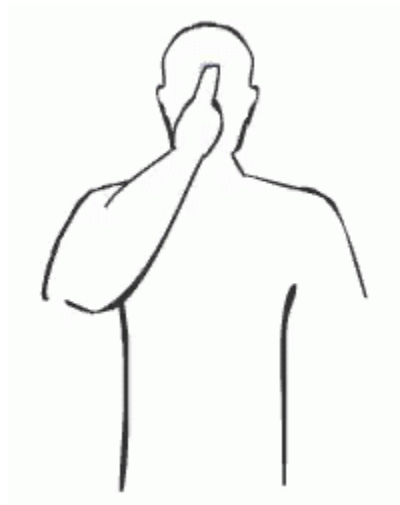
