HOME FOR ETHNIC MINORITY CHILDREN, VIETNAM

THE RNDM SISTERS IN VIETNAM HAVE EMBARKED ON AN EXCITING NEW INITIATIVE TO HELP BRING ABOUT CHANGE IN THE LIVES OF THE ETHNIC PEOPLE OF PLEIJUT, A DEVELOPING AREA NEAR GAI LAI IN THE CENTRAL HIGHLANDS. DUE TO GEOGRAPHIC ISOLATION, THEIR INABILITY TO SPEAK VIETNAMESE BECAUSE IT IS THE SECOND LANGUAGE FOR THEM, LACK OF EDUCATION, VERY POOR AND LIMITED LIVING CONDITIONS AND LACK OF ACCESS TO INFORMATION ARE SOME OF THE ISSUES AFFECTING THE ETHNIC PEOPLE FROM THE MOUNTAINOUS REGION IN THE CENTRAL HIGHLANDS.

THEIR LANDS HAVE BEEN TAKEN FROM THEM, FORCING THE ETHNIC PEOPLE TO VERY REMOTE MOUNTAINOUS AREAS WHERE THERE ARE NO SCHOOLS, LEADING TO LITTLE HOPE FOR THE FUTURE OF THE YOUNG PEOPLE.

THE PROVISION OF A NEW HOME AND HOLISTIC LEARNING CENTRE WILL HELP STUDENTS HAVE THE CHANCE TO STUDY IN THEIR OWN HOMELAND. IN THE LONG TERM, THIS PROJECT COULD HELP TO STOP THE WAVE OF MIGRANT PEOPLE WHO ARE MOVING FROM THE RURAL AREA TO CITIES.

Simon Peter replied, 'You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.' And Jesus answered him, 'Blessed are you, Simon Bar-Jonah! For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my Father who is in heaven. And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my Church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.'

On Sunday, we celebrated the Solemnity of Saint Peter and Saint Paul. They were two of the first martyrs,

Jesus proclaimed Peter as the first Pope: “You are Peter, and on this rock I will build my Church.”

Saint Paul was once a persecutor of early Christians, but he became a follower of Christ after a powerful revelation on the road to Damascus.

They share a feast day because together they represent unity in the Gospel.

In this passage, Jesus asks His disciples two crucial questions: "Who do people say that I am?" and "Who do you say that I am?". Peter answered: "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God". Then, Jesus made Peter the first Pope.

There are three powerful themes to reflect on:

1. Just like He asked the disciples, Jesus is asking you the same question today. It's easy to believe in Jesus because your parents, friends, or culture tell you to. But faith becomes real when you take a moment to figure out who He is to you personally.

2. Peter didn't get his answer by being the smartest person in the room; God revealed it to him. Similarly, God gives you the intuition, wisdom, and strength to stand firm, like a rock, when you face peer pressure or difficult situations.

3. It is incredibly encouraging that Peter is the one Jesus chooses to build His church upon. Peter made countless mistakes and sometimes let his emotions get the best of him. Jesus didn't wait for Peter to be perfect; He loved him and trusted him right where he was.

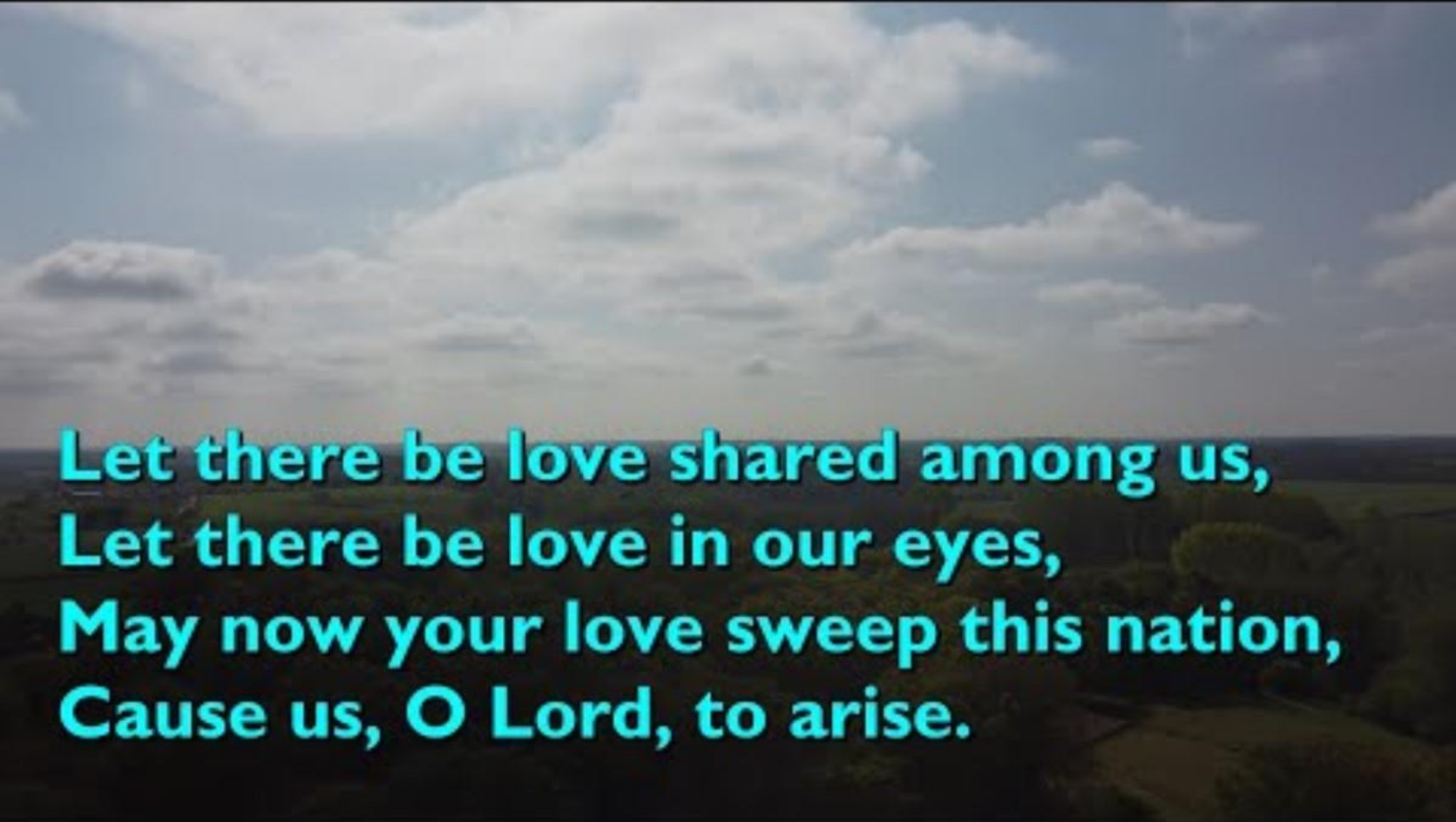
Today we take a moment to reflect on our Catholic Social Teaching theme for this term: Family and Community.

Jesus, I trust in You.



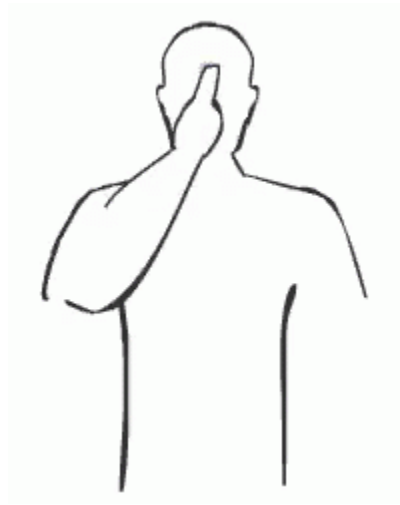


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
