UPDATED LETTER REGARDING SACRED HEART DAY AND OTHER KEY DATES

I hope this letter finds you well.

Thank you for your support during the heatwave.

Due to the weather we have revised the schedule for Sacred Heart Day and removed the outdoor activities so students will finish college slightly earlier. Please see revised times below:

- **Sacred Heart Day:** We celebrate our feast day on Friday 26th June 2026 with awards & rewards and a BBQ inside for the college community. Students are to wear their House tee-shirts and either their uniform skirt/trousers or their P.E. shorts. The traditional House sing-off has been postponed and will now take place at the end of Sports Day on 10th July. Students will be dismissed after Sacred Heart Day as follows:

Year 7: 12:00 p.m.

Year 8: 12:10 p.m.

Years 9 & 10: 12:20 p.m.

For all our students the Summer term is a busy and productive time, filled with opportunities for learning, growth and celebration. We ask for your continued support in ensuring that students arrive at college ready to learn and in line with our expectations; all are expected to be on time at 8:20 a.m. in form classes, wear full and correct uniform and footwear, as per the website. Make-up, false nails and eyelashes are not permitted. Your daughter will be asked to remove them and may be sent home to correct infringements if necessary. Students are always given the opportunity to correct them first.

Attendance and punctuality remain a key priority to success. Please ensure your daughter arrives promptly to college each day with the correct equipment.

As well as academic work there will be a full range of enrichment activities, trips and events throughout the remainder of this term:

- **Activities Days:** Wednesday 8th & Thursday 9th July 2026. All information about events for your daughter's year group will be sent separately by her Head of Year. These days are an important part of the curriculum and are compulsory for all. Your daughter will require suitable clothing and weather protection for all eventualities, including sun cream, a hat and a water bottle as well as a packed lunch.
