



Dress Code – PE Uniform

PE is a compulsory part of the college curriculum and requires all pupils to bring the appropriate kit to every lesson. Failure to take part in a lesson results in lack of progress and attainment.

Should your daughter be unable to take part in a lesson because of illness or injury we will require a letter explaining the reason. However, she will still be expected to wear her kit. This means she will be wearing the appropriate clothing for the activity and can assist with umpiring or coaching.

Should your daughter forget to bring her kit to the lesson she will be expected to borrow kit, including trainers. She will receive a detention on the second occasion and a letter home to you on the third.

- Navy blue shorts or skort (not both)
- Navy tracksuit (top and bottoms) bought from the school shop only
- White sports socks
- Trainers with non-marking soles
